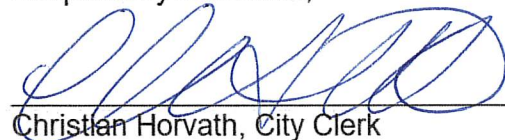
12. Matters From Staff

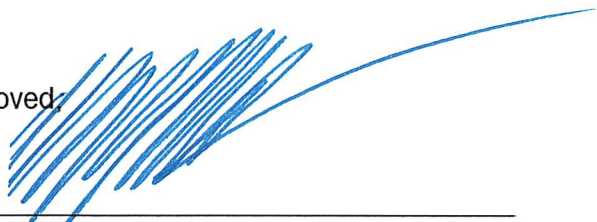
